Who each party is.

You (the user) and the Nova Scotia Health Authority

NSHA = Nova Scotia Health Learning Institute for Health Care Providers as part of Nova Scotia Health Authority

What the product is

Genius (student information system). A student information system is an information data platform that is built for the unique needs of the Learning Institute (LI) team and learners.

What rules and regulations must be followed during the use period

These rules and regulations apply upon account creation in Genius.

Use of user ID and password

You are solely responsible for all usage or activity on your account. We require you to take reasonable efforts to ensure your username and password are protected and not used without your knowledge or consent or on your behalf by others.

Use of the website by you

Each user must evaluate, and bear all risks associated with the use of any content, including any reliance on the accuracy, completeness, or usefulness of such content.

Under no circumstances will the Nova Scotia Health Authority be liable in any way for any content, including, but not limited to, liability for any errors or omissions in any content or any loss or damage of any kind incurred as a result of the use of any content posted, emailed or otherwise transmitted via the NSHA's websites.

The NSHA does not control supplied content posted to the websites and, as such, does not guarantee the accuracy, integrity, or quality of such content. Content, whether publicly posted or privately transmitted, is the sole responsibility of the person from whom such content originated. Information Use

The Learning Institute collects registration and demographic data of its learners including name, email, address, emergency contact, zone and unit employed, manager name and employee number (for NS Health staff only). This information is used to provide the organization with workforce data on specialty and entry to practice education. Learner demographic and registration information are shared within the Brightspace and Genius platforms.
